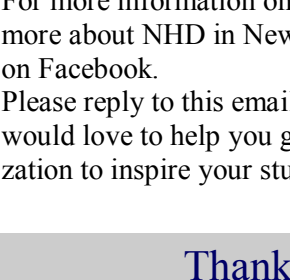


### 2013 Theme Announced
